1 Introduction


The Subtitles Generator Tool allows users to generate subtitle files for exported WebCCTV movies. These subtitle files (.smi) are automatically loaded when played in Windows Media Player.



SAMI (Synchronized Accessible Media Interchange) is a Microsoft accessibility initiative released in 1998. The structured markup language is designed to simplify creating captions for media playback on a PC. SAMI documents are text, and can be written in any text editor and have .smi or .sami as file extension. The subtitles generated by the Subtitle Generator Tool have .smi as file extension.

Showing subtitles allows the user to see images in combination with their real time which makes it possible to do detailed playbacks of exported WebCCTV movies without using the WebCCTV application itself.

The Subtitle Generator Tool can be used on any PC where exported WebCCTV movies are stored or located.

If you do not agree to the terms of this SLA,

- (a) you may not use the Software,
- (b) if you have received physical copies of the Software from Quadrox, you must promptly return the uninstalled Software, and all accompanying items as defined above, to Quadrox within ten (10) days of your receipt, in exchange for which you will receive a full refund of any paid license fees, and
- (c) you must immediately remove from your systems and destroy any and all copies of the Software and all of its component parts.

1. CONTROLLING LANGUAGE.

The controlling language of this SLA will be English. Quadrox has provided translations in other languages solely for the convenience of the Customer.

2. GRANT OF LICENSE.

Subject to the terms and conditions of this SLA, Quadrox hereby grants you a nonexclusive, nontransferable license ("Software License") to use the enclosed Software within the Territory, in the operating environment identified by Quadrox, on any number of computers for as long as you like. The software is however NOT Public Domain software.

For purposes hereof, "Territory" means, for a "U.S. Version" the United States and Canada, and for the "International Version" all countries except those countries where exportation or transmission is prohibited by any applicable EU, U.S. or other law or regulation, or in which any provision of this SLA is not enforceable Customer represents that it has complied with any regulations or registration procedures required by applicable law to make this license enforceable.

This SLA does not grant you any rights in connection with any trademarks or service marks of Quadrox. Maintenance for the Software is subject to separate charges and is governed by Quadrox's standard maintenance policy, which policy is available from Quadrox in written form and is subject to change without prior notice.

3 Subtitle Creation

This chapter explains the design and working of the tool. The intention of the tool is creating subtitles for exported WebCCTV movies. Creating a subtitle is done by a simple step procedure.

3.1 Accept License Agreement

The first time you start the Subtitle Generator Tool on a computer, you have to accept the license agreement. Please read it carefully before accepting. You can't use the Subtitle Generator Tool without accepting the license agreement (See Chapter **2. License Agreement**).



3.2 Movies and Folder selection

Once the license agreement has been accepted, the following screen will be the first screen when you open the Subtitle Generator Tool:

Please execute the following steps in order to prepare the subtitle creation:

- 1. Select folder with exported movies with Browse button.
- 2. If preferred, change folder where you want the subtitle to be saved with the **Change** button (Optional).



By default the Subtitles Generator Tool uses the path of the folder with exported movies which has been selected in step 1.

3. Select the movie by clicking the **checkbox** in front of the movie.



Click **Refresh** button if you want to refresh the list to see if new or other exported movies are found. Refreshing the list makes all checked found movies unchecked.

4. If you selected all the movies for which you want to create a subtitle, click Next.

If a subtitle file already exists, a prompt will appear to ask you what you want to do:

If you want to exit the application, click Exit.

The screen is divided in three sections:

- **Subtitles creation successful:** For each movie file in this section a subtitle was successfully created and saved in the output folder.
- **Subtitles creation failed:** If the Subtitle Generator Tool wasn't able to create a subtitle for certain movies, these movies will appear in this section.
- Windows Media Player instructions: The bottom section explains how to configure windows media player 9, 10 and 11 in order to be able to load the subtitles when the movie is opened in WMP. See chapter 4. Windows Media Player for more information.



You only have to follow the Windows Media Player instructions once, i.e. the first time when you want to open a WebCCTV exported movie with subtitles on a PC.

If you want to go back to the selection screen, click **Back**.

If you want to exit the application, click Exit.

4 Windows Media Player

This chapter explains how to play subtitles together with exported WebCCTV movies in Windows Media Player 9, 10 and 11.

4.1 Configuration

Configuring Windows Media Player is easy and takes approximately one minute.


You only have to do this configuration the **first time** that you are going to play subtitles together with exported WebCCTV movies!

To configure Windows Media Player, follow the steps below depending on your Windows Media Player version¹.

4.1.1 Windows Media Player 9


Open Windows Media Player and execute following steps:

• Go to Play > Captions and Subtitles and select On if available or Captions



• Close Windows Media Player

¹ You can see which version of Windown Media Player is installed on your computer by opening the Help \rightarrow About Windows Media Player menu in Windows Media Player.




4.1.2 Windows Media Player 10

Open Windows Media Player and execute following steps:


• Go to Play > Captions and Subtitles and select On if available or Captions



• Go to **Tools > Options > Security** tab, select **Show local captions when present** and click **Apply.**



• Close Windows Media Player




You can now play exported WebCCTV movies together with subtitles.


4.1.3 Windows Media Player 11

Open Windows Media Player and execute following steps:


• Go to Play > Captions and Subtitles and select On if available or Captions



• Go to **Tools > Options > Security** tab, select **Show local captions when present** and click **Apply**.



• Close Windows Media Player



You can now play exported WebCCTV movies together with subtitles.

4.2 Play Movie and Subtitle

Playing an exported movie together with its subtitles is done automatically if the following conditions are met:

• Windows Media Player is configured (see Chapter 4.1 Configuration)



You only have to do this configuration the **first time** that you are going to play subtitles together with exported WebCCTV movies!

- Your subtitle file is located in the same folder as your exported WebCCTV movie
- Your subtitle file has the same name as the exported WebCCTV movie

To play a movie, double click on it. Windows Media Player will open and start playing the movie and the subtitle. When the movie is playing, the subtitles are shown below the video image.



As time elapses, the subtitle will change. This refresh is done every second.

The following information can be found in the subtitle:

- Computer Name: Name of the computer where the movie has been exported.
- Camera Name: Name of the camera on the WebCCTV server.
- Date & Time: Date and time at that moment of the recording.
